History Where It Happened

Revolutionary War battle fought here on July 7, 1777
Only Revolutionary War battle in what would become Vermont
One of best-preserved Revolutionary War battlefields
Important battle during the American Revolution's Northern Campaign
Listed in the National Register of Historic Places
